## PROSPECT PARK GETS 2<sup>nd</sup> SET OF LIGHTS

The City of Fredericton installed lights at the upper Prospect field and it should be completed in time for the upcoming national tournament. This will allow for night games on both fields during the summer and teams & leagues in the Fredericton area are looking forward to now having two lit fields in the same complex.
